
**REPORT OF “CHALO COLLEGE ABHIYAN AND COLLEGE

part in the college programs and activities and to make the GIDC Degree Engineering College by its NAME and FAME.




### **Sapt Dhara Gaan and Dharti Ki Shaan Hai Manu Ki Santan...Gaan:**
